2022-2026 Calhoun County Democratic Executive Committee (CCDEC)

Candidates may qualify for vacancies on the Calhoun County Democratic Executive Committee at this time, and ending August 24, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. **Election date August 27.**

IMPORTANT: All candidates for nomination to any qualified position must be present at the Aug. 27th meeting to be elected. There is a \$50 qualifying fee.

Candidates may qualify for the following vacancies during this period:

County Commission District Vacancies --- These vacancies are based upon the five County Commission Districts and divided equally between men and women. To find your County Commission District, go to www.alabamavotes.gov.

The At-Large Caucus Vacancies are not based on the commission districts.

Filers must submit the following documents to qualify:

[Declaration of Candidacy](#) - Downloadable qualifying form.

The Executive Committee positions require the [Declaration of Candidacy](#) form (Downloadable Qualifying form) be submitted along with the [\\$50 Qualifying Fee](#) and the [Statement of Interest Form](#).

On the Declaration of Candidacy form **DO NOT** check any of the boxes on the form **NOR** fill out the forms mentioned in the checkbox areas in the middle of the page. **DO** complete the top line and the entire bottom portion below the sections containing the checkboxes. **DO** complete the Declaration Statement for the Office and District for which you are qualifying. (Examples: “Calhoun County Commission District 5 (Male) Vacancy” **AND/OR** “Diversity Youth Caucus”)

All information requested on the [Statement of Interest](#) form is required to be completed.

WARNING: Qualifying forms must be received prior to the August 24th 4:00 p.m. qualifying deadline regardless of postmark.

- **DO NOT** send your forms to the Montgomery address on the Declaration of Candidacy Form. Instead, send to the Anniston Headquarters address below.
